A Practical Guide for Implementing of Remote learning at the Medical University - Sofia, https://help.musofia.bg/services/online_study

Remote learning requires clear regulations:

- 1. The practical exercises are obligatory, as for two or more absences the student does not receive certification.
- 2. In MU Sofia for remote learning we use **Google ClassRoom** a virtual classroom accessed with the generated emails of MU Sofia. **Google ClassRoom** is a learning platform whose main purpose is to conduct remote learning.

Training and correspondence with students will take place through the ClassRoom platform and institutional emails. During the exercise there is an active written and / or audio communication between the assistant and the students, as the assistant asks questions to some students, the answers are given in writing or orally, schemes and figures are written in the notebooks, and then with photos are sent during the practical exercise in the general chat. Students complete their homework in exercise books, and read the relevant lecture in advance.

- 3. It is not allowed to use the training channels for personal conversations and comments.
- 4. The meeting (practical exercise or lecture) is convened only by the teacher at the scheduled time, according to the approved weekly curriculum.
- 5. The colloquia will be conducted by filling in tests and oral examinations.



Transport Facilities

All Erasmus+ Incoming students can use discount cards that are at a reasonable price and these passes are issued/loaded after submission of ID card and student's paper Certificate of public transport issued by the MU-Sofia (1 hard copy for every following month).

For students having international student's identity card /ISIC/ - passes are issued/loaded after submission of ISIC card.
