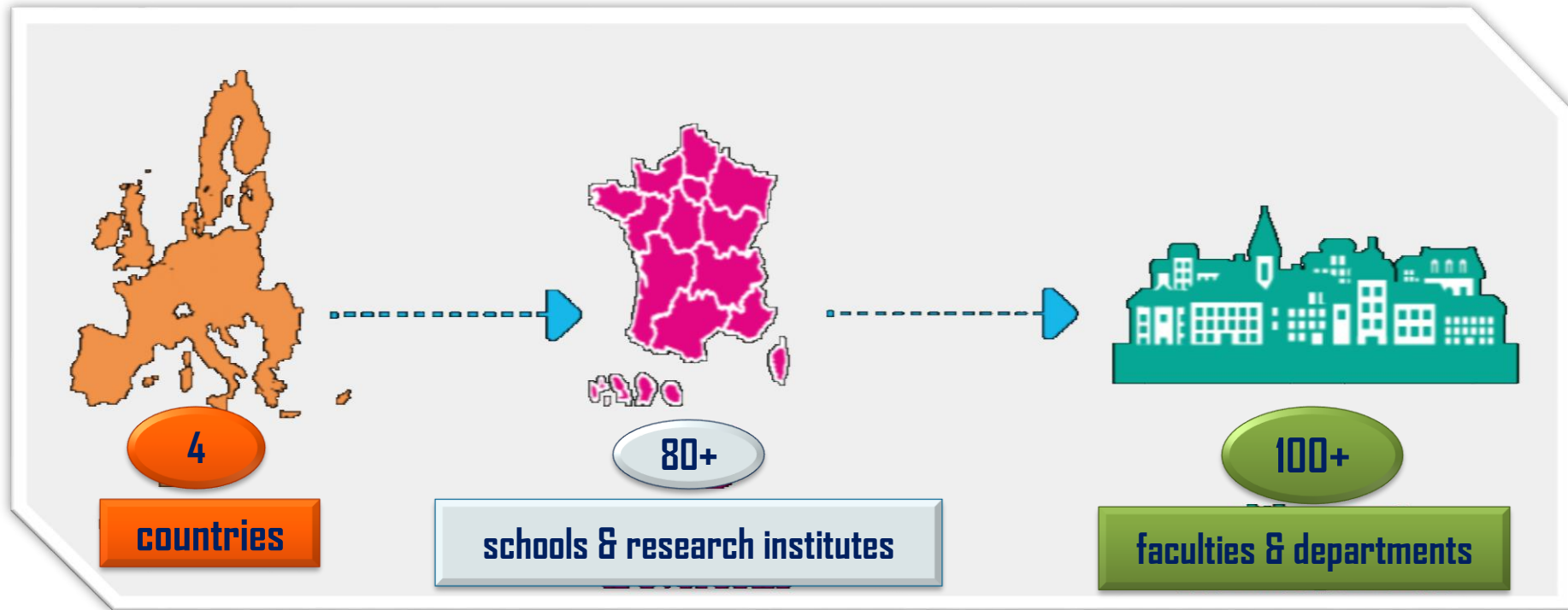

STUDENTS MOBILITY – IMPORTANT TO KNOW

Incoming and Outgoing Erasmus+ students get:

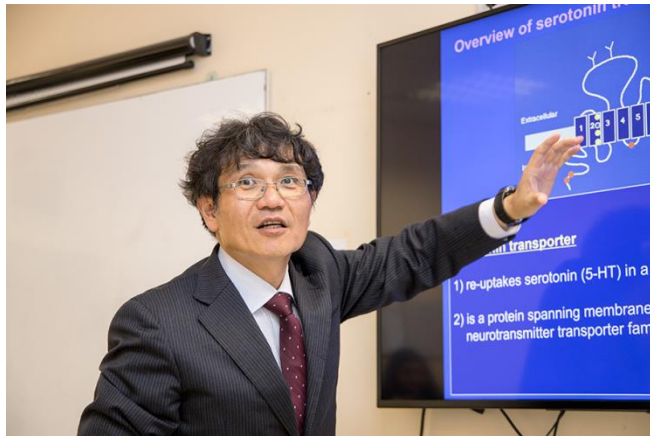
1. Erasmus+ student coursebook
2. Accommodation at the host institution
3. 50% discount for public transport
4. Full access to clinical facilities, libraries, classrooms



TEACHERS MOBILITY – IMPORTANT TO KNOW

Incoming and Outgoing Erasmus+ teachers get:

1. Assistance in scheduling their teaching program at the host institution
2. Assistance in visa processing, flight & hotel reservations
3. Full access to clinical facilities, libraries, classrooms



ORGANIZING THE MOBILITY

1. Before the mobility:

Participants submit the following documents for nomination:

- Application form
- CV & language certificates, other qualification certificates, Recommendations
- Motivation letter & Transcript of records, Certificate of enrollment

2. During the mobility:

After the nomination participants get:

- Letter of acceptance, Learning agreement, Grant agreement, Training/Teaching program

3. After the mobility:

Participants submit their reports to justify the mobility:

- Certificate of attendance, Traineeship certificate
- Online report, flight tickets & boarding passes



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Do Erasmus+ students pay academic tuition fees at the host university?

NO. Students do not pay any academic fees at the host institution.

2. How students receive the grant?

100% by bank transfer in EUR before the mobility

3. Are students eligible to get more than one ERASMUS+ grant?

YES. Students are eligible for Erasmus+ mobility for studying (3 to 12 months) or traineeship (2 to 12 months) for any bachelor, master's or doctoral degree but not in the same academic year.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

4. May the selected participants cancel their trip?

YES, but they must pay the cost of the penalty if the host university requests one, no matter the reason of cancellation.

5. How and what courses to choose for attending at the host university?

- Check the available courses at the host university's website.
- Consult with the academic Erasmus+ Faculty Coordinator to arrange the program.
- Choose equivalent or similar courses you are attending at home at the host university.

6. Are courses recognized by HEI?

YES. ECTS credits from the foreign university are recognized according to the Academic Transcript of Records for the equivalent courses in the curriculum of the host university.

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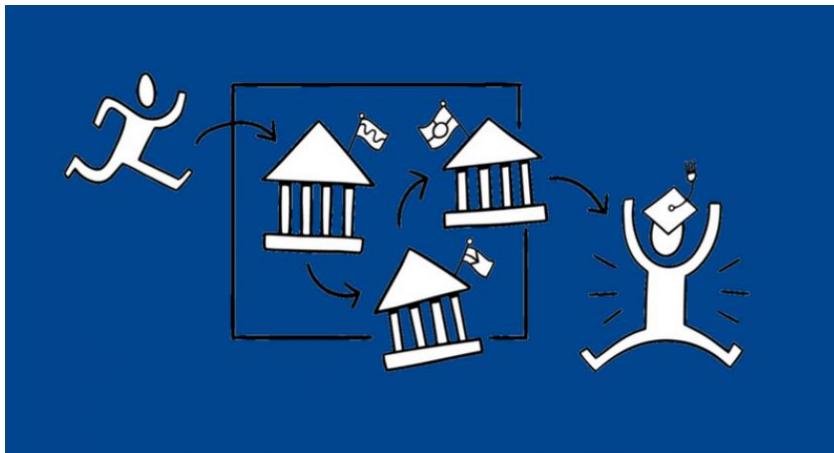
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
